Wood foundation

Reducing bills by 50 per cent is one of the reasons Brian Stewart decided on a preserved wood foundation for the house he is building in Georgetown.

According to Stewart, the wood foundation being constructed on the site east of Trafalgar Rd. just north of 15 Sideroad, is 10 per cent cheaper to construct. It's the first one to be built in Halton

"But in order reduce the heating bill, you have to have an air tight insulated home, he stressed, adding the preserved wood foundation (PWF) by itself would not cut the bill in

Stewart is intending making his home as energy efficient as possible. He has plans to have R-28 insulation installed and will have the preserved wood on the floor of his base-

Preserved foundations have been around for about 20 years, the first one built as a government experiment in Ottawa in 1961. Since then the foundstions have grown in popularity.

By the end of 1972, less than 100 foundations were built in Canada, which increased to 5,000 by the end of 1977. In the United States, 10,000 homebuilt wood preserved foundations.
