### Dairy princess

### \$200 for emergency calls

An after hours emergency service will be available to Halton Region residents through the Milton Fire Department at a cost of \$200 per month. The emergency service was discussed at Wednesday's administration and finance committee meeting and will go before council today (Wednesday) for approval.

"I really question the \$200 fee on the basis that the phones are answered anyway and are not a lot of extra work," said Burlington councillor James Grieve. Milton Fire Chief James Coulson attended the meeting and said he set the \$200 fee after looking at "what private industries would charge for the service."

"And we'll have radio service as well as the telephone service," he added. The service is needed, according to Public Works Director Bob Moore because the present system of having one operator at Burlington answer the calls has been unsatisfactory so far.

### Feldenkrais workshop at Sheridan campus

We are creatures of habit and those habits can be damaging to our body function and nervous system. One way to alleviate this damage is by participating in Feldenkrais, a form of "anti-exercise," according to Don Himes. He will lead a workshop on this subject at Sheridan College, Oakville Campus, Saturday, November 20. Feldenkrais is basically a sequence of

gentle movements that help to release muscular tension and bring out greater flexibility and co-ordination of body functioning. The Feldenkrais philosophy is based on the idea that most people are causing unnecessary strain on their bodies, says Himes. "Because we don't investigate alternatives in movement, these habits can tend to be harmful. By trying to

find your natural way of moving, your nervous system and body function may be cleared of damaging results." Himes, who currently provides the background music for the Mr. Dressup television program, is a teacher at the National Ballet School and former principal of the Toronto School of Dance. He has found that he had developed bad habits himself before practising Feldenkrais. "Musicians are famous for getting into messes—a pianist will sit in the same position, a violinist will hold the instrument in the same manner. The body can cope for awhile but eventually as you enter your 30s, the body tells us that all is not O.K." Registration for the 10 a.m.—4 p.m. workshop, sponsored by the School of Liberal and General Studies, is \$25. For further details, contact the School at 845-9430, ext. 293. Pre-registration is advised.

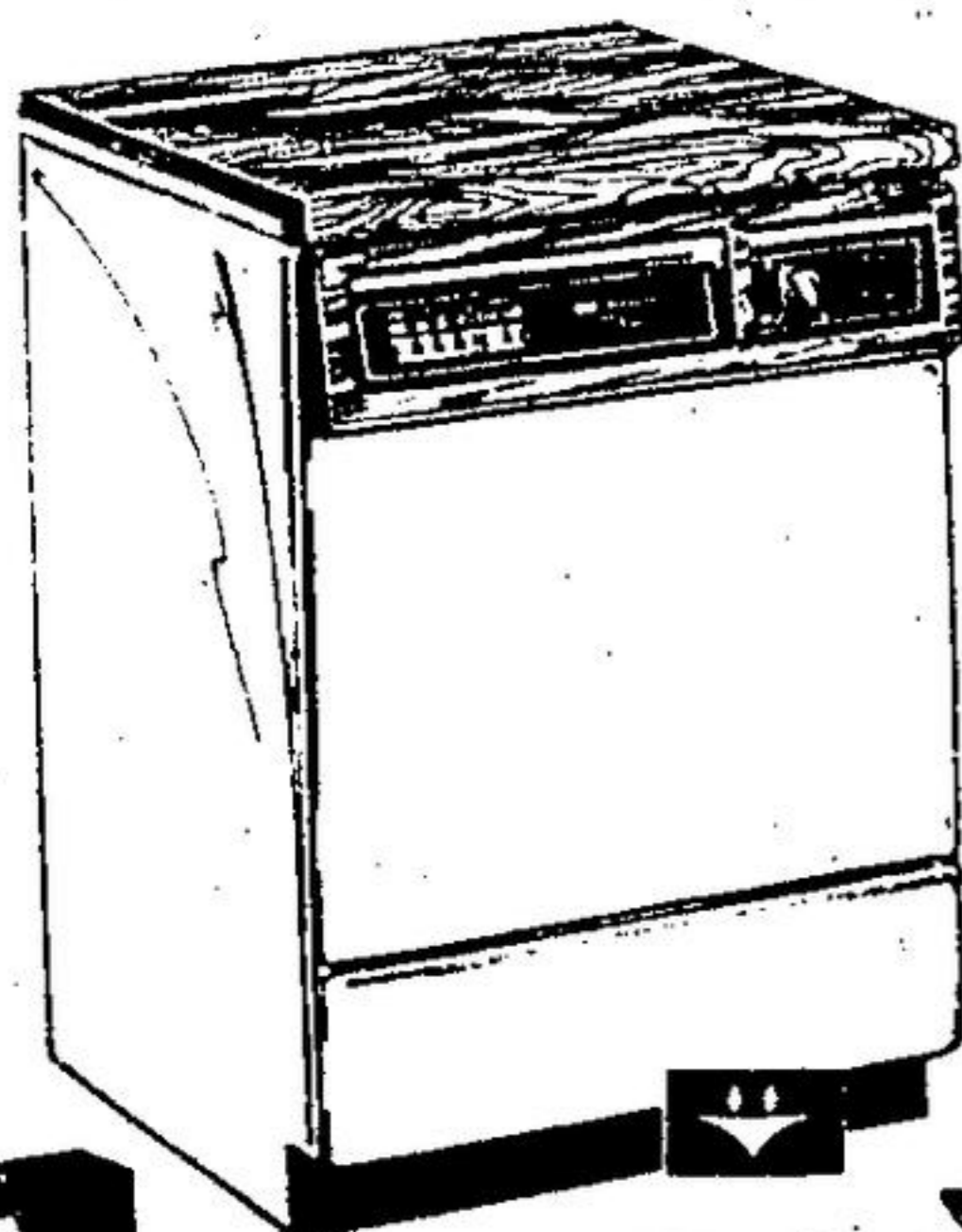
