Robert Bateman to speak

The regular meeting of the Arts and Crafts of Georgetown was held at the home of Evelyn Charles, RR 3 Georgetown. Conveners gave their reports concerning the 40th Exhibition and Sale, held at the North Halton Golf and Country Club and received the thanks of the President, Patricia Beer for a job very well done.

One of the character members, Jen Thompson recalled that shortly after the war, when much knitting had been done, the Government became concerned with the lack of other crafts. At this time the Ontario Government sponsored a class in weaving, supplying eight looms and a teacher, enabling eight members of the group to start the weaving section of the Arts and Crafts of Georgetown.

Craft classes planned for the coming year are quilting and stained glass.

On May 19 next year, Robert Bateman, well known Canadian wildlife artist, will be guest speaker.
