Fee cuts hurt Board

The Halton Board of Education stands to lose \$7,400 a year through a provincial revision of the tuition fees system. In past years, the board would charge Ontario residents living outside Halton \$131 a month to attend elementary schools and \$176 to attend secondary. The new regulation calls for \$50 a month for either elementary or elementary. This compares with an average local tax of \$58 per month, said a board report. In the past, the amount charged outside residents reflected the average per-pupil levy on the taxpayers, said the report. Ron Chapman, superintendent of educational services, estimated that there are only about 14 students fitting into the category. Most are here as a result of temporary relocation because of difficulties at home. A few are hockey players attending school while they play, he said. It is not often that somebody is here specifically for educational advantages, he added.

Car skids on ice — hits ditch

Two Halton Hills men escaped serious injury last Friday evening when their car collided with a culvert. According to Guelph OPP, Danny Bender, RR3 Acton, was driving his car southbound on Wellington County Road 50 and braked as he came over a hill and came onto a curve in the road. His car skidded on the icy road and he entered the ditch on the opposite of the road, and struck the culvert. Bender received minor injuries, and his passenger, David Thompson, of Georgetown received no injuries. A passing motorist took the men to Georgetown Hospital. Police estimate damage to the vehicle at \$1,000.

Burlington man winner Bateman art

The winner of an original Robert Bateman painting awarded as the prize in a lottery to raise funds for the Crawford Lake Indian Village and Conservation Centre has already been offered \$22,000 for the work of art. However, Don and Ruth Taylor of Burlington have no intention of selling it. The lottery was organized by Bill and Lisa Dodd, owners of the Scrimshaw and Co. art gallery in Oakville. All proceeds go to the campaign to raise \$700,000 to rebuild the prehistoric Iroquois Village that once stood beside the lake at Guelph Line and Steeles Avenue, and to create a new imperative centre. The sale of tickets for the Bateman painting raised \$16,000, which was 60 per cent higher than organizers had anticipated as a reasonable goal. The painting was valued at between \$15,000 and \$20,000 before the lottery on October 3. Taylor is the past chairman of the board of directors of the Kortright Waterfowl Park, near Guelph. He has known Bob Bateman for about five years, since the time the artist was appointed an honorary member of the same board. The \$16,000 raised through the lottery puts the Crawford Lake campaign over the \$100,000 mark, ahead of the target established for the first six months of the three-way campaign. Reconstruction of the longhouses and palisade around the 900 year old village is scheduled to begin soon.
