Obituary

Eccles Albert McClure

Eccles Albert McClure, a Glen Williams area milk producer, passed away in St. Michael's Hospital, Toronto, on October 10, after a month's illness. He was 62.

Mild-mannered and soft-spoken, Mr. McClure was popular during his young adult years in Halton agricultural societies. At a young age he became a member of the Halton Calf Club where he received valuable instruction on the care and nurture of the Jersey calf; this experience provided the training for his life-long work with a large herd of registered Jersey cattle.

He was born July 20, 1920 at Lot 17, Concession 10, in the Township of Esquesing. His birthplace was incorporated in the Town of Georgetown and is known as the Delrex Industrial Park. He was the son of William Albert McClure and Sarah Jane Eccles and attended Chapel Street Public School and later the old Georgetown High School. Leaving school at an early age he assisted the family in the operation of their farm.

In 1955 Mr. McClure purchased the present farm on the 10th Line of Esquesing and farmed there until his illness. He was the great grandson of James Eccles the first owner of the land; a pioneer who arrived then from Ballymean, Northern Ireland, in the 1830's.

He was active for many years in the Halton Jersey Breeders' Association.

The funeral service was held from the McClure-Jones Funeral Home on October 12, with Reverend Peter Barrow conducting the service. Pallbearers were William Hutchinson, Delbert Arnott, Roy Hansen, Jack Harris, Stephen Dolson, and Ronald Kirkwood. Interment followed in Greenwood Cemetery, Georgetown.

He is survived by his brother John Laughlin McClure, and his sister Agnes and Islay. He also leaves two nieces, Mary Jane Barrett, Mississauga, and Ishly Christena McClure, Georgetown. His two nephews are William John McClure, Cheltenham and Stuart Eccles McClure, Georgetown.
