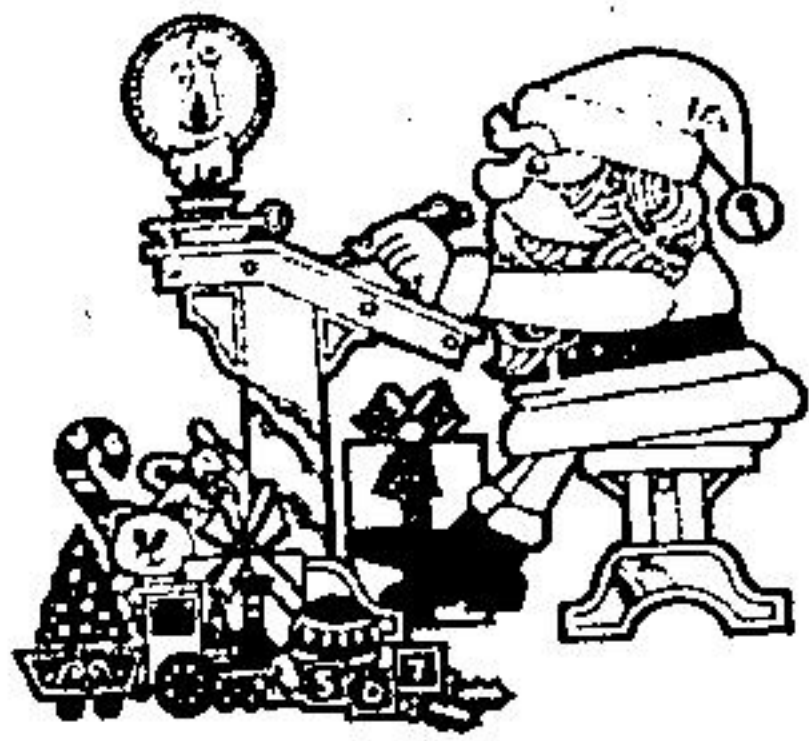


Glass studio in Artisan Village

Halton Glass Studio was completed in September, 1982, at the old Hide House in Acton, in just four weeks. The studio is located in the centre of an "Artisan Village", a cluster of craft studios and galleries in a renovated warehouse built in 1899.

The glass studio has been designed and built by Peter Keogh and is run under his direction. The hot equipment consists of a 160lb. day tank; glory hole, an electric annealer; the coldworking facilities include a 30" grinding wheel, diamond saw, belt sander and sand-blaster.

The studio is home to artists Peter Keogh, Robin Fineberg, Tony Lee and Kathy Wood. Peter Keogh teaches sculpture, semi-hot and cold working techniques at Sheridan College, School of Craft and Design in Mississauga, Ontario.
