Bateman spearheads outdoor education

World-famous wildlife artist Bob Bateman. who taught in Halton for almost 20 years, is hoping that teachers from across Halton Region will take advantage of the outdoor education opportunities at Crawford Lake.

Bateman and his

wife, Birgit, are co-

chairman of the Halton Region Conservation Foundation education which is committee, promoting knowledge about the unique nature of Crawford Lake, located near Guelph Line and Steeles Ave. in Milton. unique layered sediment at the bottom of the lake permits acdating material found in the sediment and led to the discovery of the most dated accurately Indian prehistoric Village in Canada.








