

Winter budget depleted sidestreet plowing slow

Attempts to cut back on overtime may mean snow is not plowed as speedily on the sidestreets in Town this winter.

With the works department winter maintenance budget already depleted at the end of November. Town Engineer Bob Austin predicted a reduced level of service particularly on crescents, cul-desacs and dead-end streets, as well as recreation facilities.

His report stated depending on the amount of snow accumulation and weather forecast, operations will end after the normal workshift, provided main throughfares have been cleared. The lesstravelled streets will be plowed the next morning.

He added judgment calls will have to be made about overtime if conditions are hazardous even on minor streets.

He noted there are 37 job allocations in the works department but at present only 34 are filled. le explained, discounting the mechanics and garbage pick-up men, only 26 are available for winter control, provided other duties do not keep them busy elsewhere.

Snow will not be trucked away on cul-de-sacs and dead-end streets, as it has in the past, unless conditions seem to be dangerous.

Through a charge-back system to the Region, Maple Avenue westerly from Guelph Street will have the snow taken away.

Bridges are another area where snow is trucked away. The Ministry of Transportation and Communications insists on this procedure. Other areas where high snowbanks cause visibility problems such as intersections will also have the

snow removed. Snowplowing of the fire department and Georgetown Volunteer Ambulance Service parking lots may be contracted to private operators, both in the interest of speedy removal and cutting cost of works staff overtime.

The Town will continue its policy of only plowing sidewalks in a few hazardous areas, as soon as possible after the roads are cleared.

Councillor Marilyn Serjeantson suggested the sidewalk on Mountainview from the Sargent Road senior citizens' apartment building up to the traffic lights at the entrance to the plaza be plowed, and Councillor Rick Bonnette said the same service should be available to the residents of the senior citizens' apartment on Elizabeth Drive, Ac-

Councillor Mike Armstrong warned plowing sidewalks means higher taxes, and stated at council he would oppose clearing sidewalks no matter where they are located.
