Seniors trip

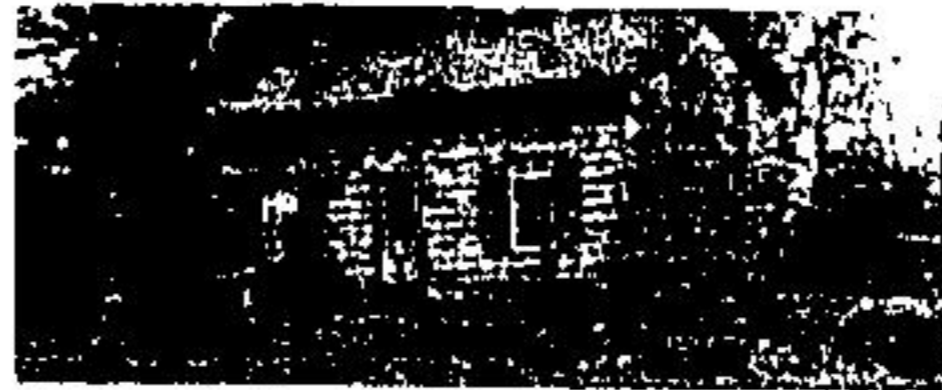

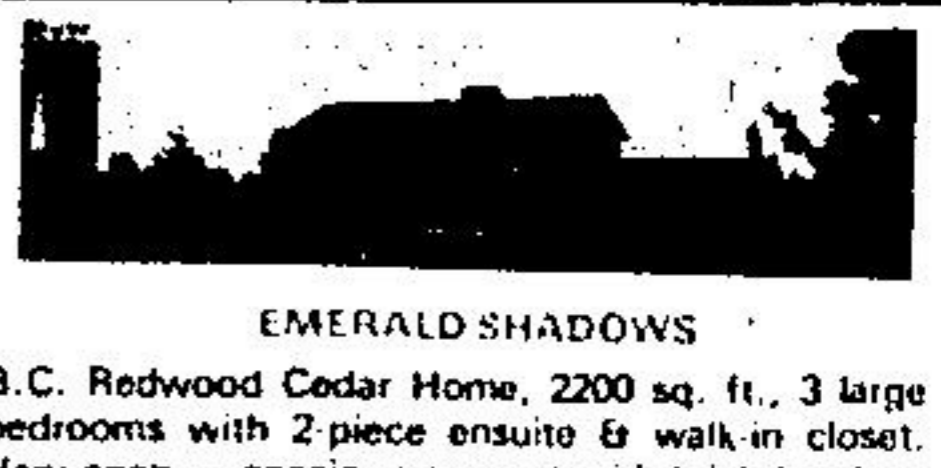
