## Day Care course

Sheridan College has revived its family day care program as an evening program through the college's Continuing Education Department, in Community Services.

Terminated as a day-time program last year, the rejuvenated family day care program has been redesigned to meet the current needs of people in the community who want to establish themselves as day care providers in their own homes.

Continuing Education Dean Gary Britton, said the new design of the program should make it even more practical for those currently providing care who would find it difficult to attend classes during the day.



It is also of interest to mothers who want to enrich their own family life.

The eight-course, 150-hour program may be completed in two years if students study one or two subjects per semester.

Upon completion, students receive a family day care certificate which is recognized as an accredited early childhood elective at Sheridan College.
