

Participents will be closely monitored over five year period. Abnormalities will be detected in the earliest stages, when chances of treatment and cure are

high. medical examination takes 13 to 45 minutes. The remainder of the day may be spent at the Toronto Eaton's Centre and surrounding boutiques which are all within easy walking distance of the hospital.


