

### **Dunn guilty** selling drug

David Dunn of Acton pleaded guilty to one count of trafficking in cannibis marijuana, in Milton County Court Monday. He ap-

peared before Judge J. Carnwath. Dunn was arrested last February and charged with trafficking in a region wide drug sweep following a joint RCMP and Halton Regional Police undercover opera-

tion last winter. . According to Federal Prosecutor Bill Manderson, on January 7 Dunn sold an undercover RCMP officer approximately half a pound of marijuana for \$330 after meeting him in the 747 Restaurant on Mill St. The officer drove Dunn to a home on Agnes St. where he picked up eight bags of marijuana.

Gerald Punnett, defense lawyer for Dunn, contended that his client was merely a gobetween for the police officer and the actual trafficker. Dunn agreed to get the marijuana, but did not make any money on the deal as he gave all the money to the dealer, who has also been charged, he noted.

Punnett added that the officer had approached Dunn prior to January 7 and asked if he knew where he could get marijuana. He also pointed out the officer made several telephone calls at all times of the day and night to the Dunn home and hinted at harrassment.

Manderson assured Judge Carnwath that the telephone calls were merely a method of communication, but he did not feel they constituted undue pressure to make a sale. Dunn will be sentenced March 4.







