# Clergy Comment

As a clergyman, one of the common questions I am asked is: how do I know that God exists or how can I truly feel in my life the presence of the Christ.

One of the answers may be that we are just unaware of His presence, much like we may be unaware of the presence of friendship or even love. We know that love and friendship exist—yet we don't explicitly see or hear it.

In sports we hear about a team being favored because of the "intangibles" i.e. desire or momentum. It is there but we can not see it.

Maybe we don't know God exists—or "feel" God in my life because we don't want to know; He may ask too much of me. Maybe we are just too reluctant to change.

Change is an integral part of the Christian life. We are destined to enter into a process of continual change and conversion as we come to understand the mystery of Christ and the implications that it has for our living the Christian life. Some changes are dramatic, and some are not so dramatic but rather occur without our realizing it.

Paul was a man who underwent a dramatic change in his life after his encounter with Christ. Paul, earlier known as Saul, had been one who had his mind made up, and nothing was going to stand in his way. He had been a resolute Jew and staunch defender of his Jewish faith. In his religious zeal and blindness, he had intended to go to Damascus to arrest, imprison, and persecute men and women who were living according to the new way of Christ. He set out for Damascus, and along the way he was stopped in his tracks. Something happened. He fell to the ground and heard a voice: "Saul, Saul, why do you persecute me?" What was taking place was a personal encounter with Christ which would dramatically change his life and mission.

Seeing Paul undergo such a dramatic and radical conversion on the road to Damascus, we may feel neglected or overlooked. We might envy Paul for his personal encounter with Christ. Why couldn't we be so fortunate as to meet Christ and to have it laid out clearly for us what direction our lives would take? But, as we might long for this type of experience, let us not fail to see that we do encounter Christ along the path of life. He is present and is calling us to enter more deeply into the mystery of his life, death, and resurrection. He is calling us together to hear his word. He is calling us to pause along the way of life and to reflect upon the presence of Christ in our everyday lives, to grow more appreciative of the salvation we have received, to know this Jesus more personally, and to be witnesses to those around us of what we have seen and heard.
