Coach Tours

-See More For Your Holiday Dollar

When you buy your holiday a piece at a time there is a false feeling that not too much money is being spent. First, there's the air fare, a few weeks later having decided on an itinerary, there's the hotel reservation deposits. A small car will be a bit cramped so a medium-size is booked, with another deposit. Now you settle down to the real planning. How much will be needed in travellers cheques for meals, entrance to tourist attractions, porter's tips? What charge cards can be used at which hotels or in which countries for gasoline? (And, remember to be prepared for a shock when you get your statements back after your holiday and you wonder how you could have spent so much money. . . it always seems more when a bill is translated into Canadian dollars.)

Still feel you haven't spent much? Let's see what a coach tour vacation has to offer. Holidays by Wardair, in conjunction with Trafalgar Tours, features a variety of choice with prices including almost everything basic to your holiday. Air fare, transportation between the airport and your starting-point hotel, meals (breakfast every morning and a full dinner on most nights), a comfortable air-conditioned coach, selected hotel accommodation in very interesting places, entrance fees to some of the tourist attractions as well as hotel service charges (tips), local taxes and what is referred to as "baggage handling" which really is the porter's tip. Using the 16-day budget holiday that offers a trip from London through Europe to Rome as an example, the total holiday cost averages a little over \$80 a day and that includes everything except lunches, a few dinners and the numerous souvenirs you know you're going to collect.

Of course, as with most holidays, the price

is governed by your choice of accommodation. In the Holidays by Wardair brochure there are basically two tour styles, "first class" and "budget". The higher prices are for the "first class" hotels featuring private bathrooms. The budget prices, are for hotels that are rated as "good tourist class". These are what might be termed typical, nice, European-style hotels. The rooms are comfortable, scrupulously clean and although they usually have a wash-basin in the room, bathrooms and toilets may be shared or "down the hall". Actually, you might be surprised by some of these rooms as sometimes they are very much larger than the usual hotel room as we know it today. (When choosing a budget tour, be sure to pack a light-weight dressing gown in case you have to take that drip down the hall.)

Did you know that a coach tour is an unselfish holiday?

When holidays are being planned, especially a group of friends, one poor soul gets stuck with making all the arrangements (and during the holiday post-mortem, blamed for all the goofs). During the tour, while the driver is struggling with strange signposts, unfamiliar roads and different traffic habits, perhaps even getting used to the "wrong side of the road", there will be a constant flow of instructions and questions; "look at that," "what's this place," "stop, I want to take a picture." In fact, the driver sees very little of the area through which he/she is nervously propelling his/her rented auto.

On an escorted tour, everybody sees everything, unless you fall asleep in the comfortable reclining seats. Stops are planned at scenic and interesting places. An experienced guide explains the tour with little bits of folklore and history that are fun or interesting.
