### Three request Chinese books

A survey beld at Georgetown library shows three requests for books in Chinese, one for Dutch or German, five for French and one for Italian.

The multilingual survey was part of a program to find out what citizens were being overlooked.

Most of the request for the foreign language books were for children's literature. In Acton, the survey showed one request for Finnish, one for Ukrainian and one for

Chinese books. These were for adult books.

Library staff intends to work with the French immersion program to provide more material, and are anxious to talk to library users asking for Chinese material, since they want to find out if enough people in the community are interested to warrant a rotating book collection from other librar-

Results of the survey will be sent to the National Library in Ottawa to help plan a multilingual service.

#### Region okays tourism study

By a slim margin of 11 to 10, regional councillors voted in favor of going ahead with a tourism study, despite one councillor's objection that a housing study is far more important.

"If we can find an extra \$10,000 why can't we find an extra \$2,000 and do the housing study?" asked Burlington councillor Walter Mulkewich, who said it was unfair to those in Halton who can't find housing. "You're going to tell them we want to bring in

should go for a housing study." But other councillors said the two studies were incomparable because the region's Business Development department was going to ask the private sector to add money for the study.




