Four anti-Cruise Missile testing protesters marched from Guelph through Rockwood and Acton to Georgetown last Wednesday on their way to Saturday's big rally at Queen's Park. Along the way they stuffed mail boxes with leaflets. There were two additional walkers who weren't with this group when our photographer found them on Highway 7. The protesters are Hugh Whiteley, Valerie Huff, Keith Baechler all from Guelph and John Klassen of Kitchener-Waterloo. Two of the six protesters had started their walk in Kitchener-Waterloo and the remaining four from Guelph.

Christian Farmers meet in Georgetown

Almost 50 farmers from across Ontario attended the regular March Provincial Board meeting of the Christian Farmers Federation of Ontario in Georgetown. It was the Federation's largest attendance at a policy setting meeting to date.

John Moerman, of Kent County, was elected to a two-year term as the Federation's representative on the Ontario Farm Income Stabilization Commission.

The Board welcomed the successful establishment of the Ontario Corn Producers Association, but expressed disappointment that the new Association was planning on a membership in the Ontario Federation of Agriculture.

A Foodland Stewardship Committee is planned by the Federation to follow-up its growing concern about the impact of soil

degradation and urban encroachment.

Some delegates expressed concern that farmers had difficulty in benefitting from local gas price wars, unless they resorted to unsafe practices in fuel handling.

The Federal Government's limit of \$5,000 in farm losses as an allowable deduction from other taxable income was criticized by delegates.

The Federation endorsed the establishment of Mediation Task Forces in co-operation with OFA & OMAF for farmers in financial difficulty. The members of the Federation are willing to put a significant amount of energy into the mediation process.

A major statement on Property Tax Rebates was adopted. The Federation wants to maintain a property service tax on foodland and farm buildings.
