Bike rodeo is success

Bonnors "wait and see" in suit against Township

A Rockwood couple suing the Township of Eramosa is currently in a wait and see position.

Harry and Barb Bonner are suing the Township after repairs were done on the basement of the Rockmosa Centre without their permission.

A 10 year agreement beginning in September, 1973 ensured the couple they would have a vote on any work done to the hall, which was built on land donated by the Bonnors.

Barb Bonner explained the Township violated this agreement. She noted a letter to the Township council says the couple wants either the land given back to them, or \$32,000 in cash.

The original agreement was that the Township would purchase the 10 acres, and the Bonnors would donate the money back to the Township.

Mrs. Bonner said the matter is between the lawyers now, and because they have been on holidays, she does not know where anything stands. But, she said, it will be some time before the matter is settled.

Township council began renovations to the unfinished basement of the hall in December, 1982, only to discover a number of structural defects. Because of the busy time of year, council went ahead and paid almost \$40,000 for repairs as quickly as possible, before a disaster occurred during a dance, or other large gathering. Their actions have been the centre of controversy ever since, with allegations of nepotism, unfair tendering practices, and poor workmanship being hurled against the Township. Public meetings have done little to allay the concerns of the residents who feel their questions have not been answered regarding the repairs.
