The Coalition on the Niagara Escarpment (CONE) will challenge the report of the hearing officers on the Proposed Plan for the Niagara Escarpment in court.

CONE will apply for a judicial review and ask that the report be rewritten to include important evidence that it says was ignored in favour of pro-development interests.

The Plan was generally in favour of the preservation of the Escarpment but the Hearing Officers' report virtually destroyed it, CONE insists.

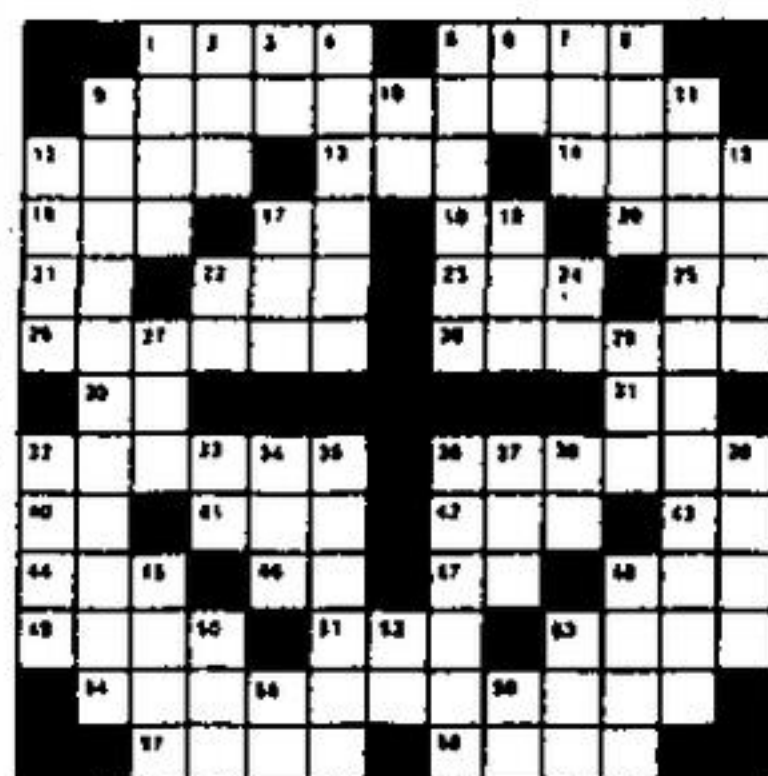

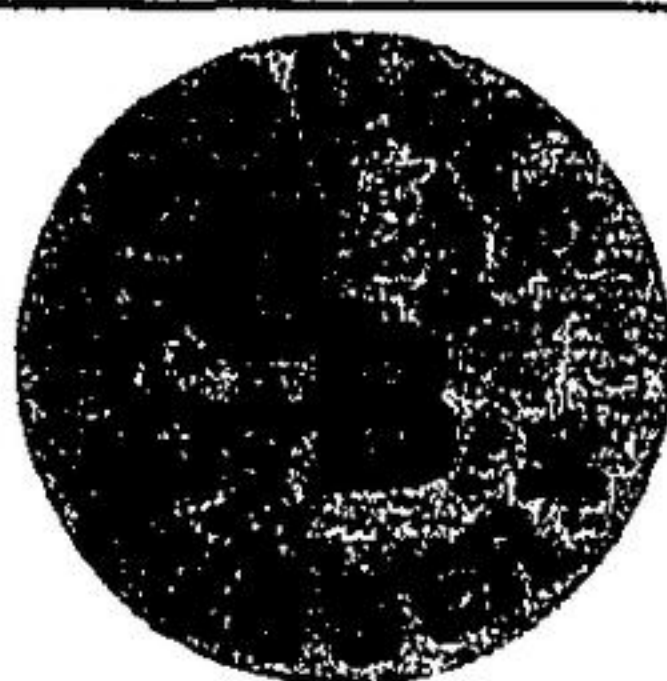

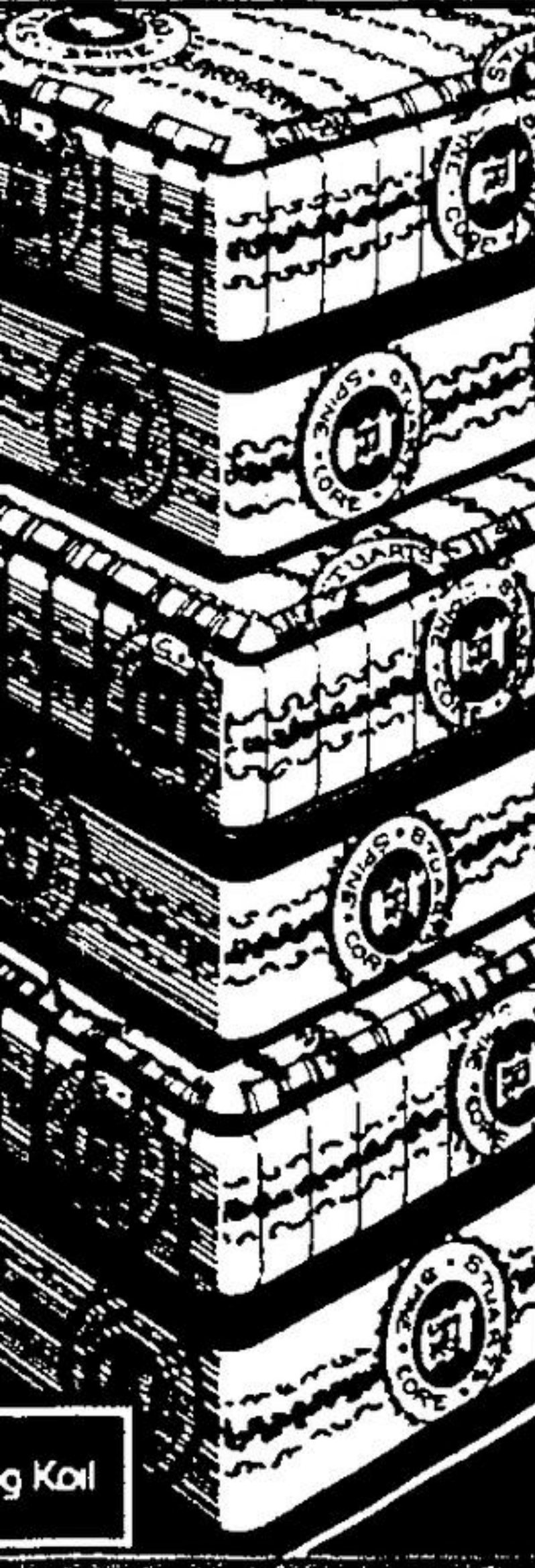
