"As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you." Today we hear the greatest commandment, which we have heard many times before. We say we love our neighbor, and yet the question is asked, "How great is your love?" Does everyone, even those we dislike, see Christ's love radiating from us?

We must be honest with ourselves and admit that our love for others does not always shine forth from us. We are not perfect, and though we have faults we continue to work on ourselves to become better Christians. We should not become discouraged; the fact that you are here today shows God that you are trying to be more Christ-like. We are here to listen to God's word and for this word to become a part of us.

Love is something that must be learned and experienced from early infancy. It must be developed and nourished. We have been privileged to know God's love and love from our families. Since we have been given so much, more will be expected from us. We must be first to love others.

In Acts, chapter 15 verses 7-21 James urges those with him to be considerate of the

newly converted Gentiles. Quoting scripture, "Hereafter, I will return and rebuild the fallen hut of David," James is asking his brothers in Christ to discontinue their Mosaic practice of circumcision on the Gentiles. In fact, he says, "It is my judgement therefore, that we ought not to cause God's Gentile converts any trouble or difficulties." How often do we make it difficult for others? We may not realize that when we are not showing love for others, we sometimes become judgmental.

Today, let us strive to become more Christ-like, so that we may radiate love to everyone, even those who try our patience and are irksome to us. The people who are difficult to love may have grown this way because they never experienced real love. With effort, by trying to find their good side and by showing them real Christian love, we could transform them and help ourselves become more Christlike. We may be surprised that they are worth loving and then enjoy their friendship. Then the words from John will have meaning for us: "All this I tell you, that my joy may be yours and your joy may be complete."

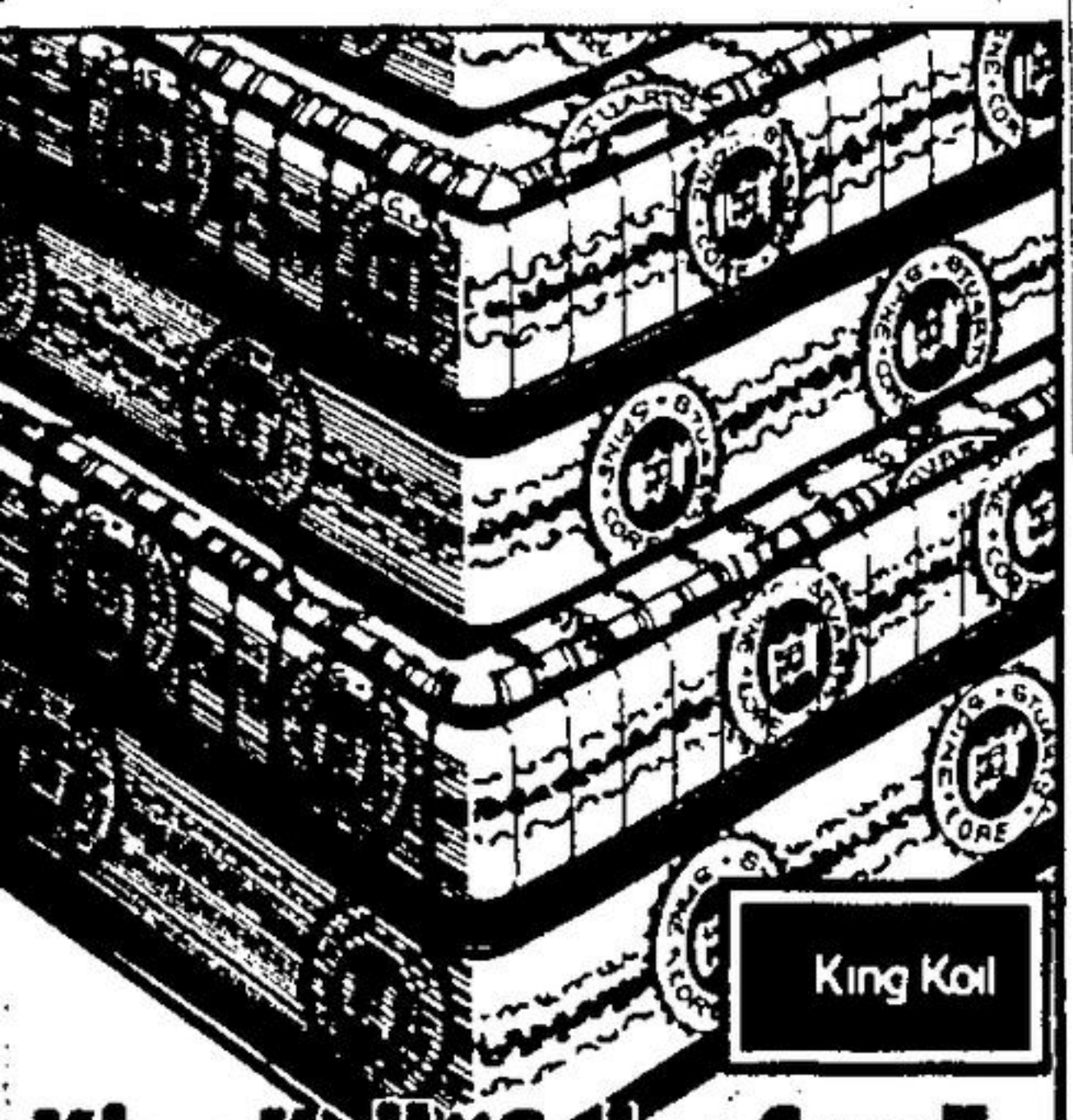
