Board seeks no rent for program

Halton Hills Library Board wants rental fees for the gallery, meeting room and theatre, in the Cultural Centre, waived, when they present free programs for the public.

Norman Elliott, a member of the library board, explained the board sought the free use only when the space is not booked.

He pointed out the programs have become so popular frequently children have to be turned away.

Asked the fee range charged now to the library board, Librarian Betsy Cornwell explained the gallery charge is \$15 an hour, the meeting room \$10 an hour, "and the theatre much higher." She said the thertre would be used less frequently than the other space, and primarily in the daytime.

Councillor Harry Levy stressed there are ongoing costs simply to maintain the building, and questioned how the board could schedule events on short notice, when the areas were vacant.

Recreation Director Tom Shepard pointed out all groups offering programs face the same problem, and suggested the library should consider a small participation charge to cover all costs involved in the programs.

Mayor Pete Pomeroy suggested the library board and recreation department try to work it out internally for the remainder of this year, and include the projected costs in next year's budget

Glenlea Plaza expansion gets official go-ahead

Expansion of the Glenlea plaza has been given the go-ahead by Halton Hils Committee of Adjustment.

Plans call for Royal Variety to expand into the present Glenlea Beauty Salon while the salon will move into the addition.

This expansion will reduce the number of parking spaces from 50 to 22 and also eliminate one loading space. In addition the sideyard setback will be reduced to 8.30 metres from the required 9.14 metres.

Committee of Ajustment ruled it was approving the expansion because it was a minor variance, follows the general intent of both the zoning bylaw and Official Plan and Town staff and committee members viewed the addition as "appropriate for the site."

At the last Committee of Adjustment meeting neighbor Nino Braida attended to complain not about the minor variance but litter problems which have arisen since Nick and Areti Karageorgiou and George and Vassa Katsikas acquired the plaza. Braida told the committee grass along the chain link fence has been allowed to grow as high as five feet, a hedge hasn't been cut andlitter isn't controlled. He said previous owners were "sympathetic" to these kinds of matters.

He asked the owners' representative at the committee meeting, Peter Van Harten, to pass on his concerns. Braida noted he has written the owners, but nothing has been done about the problems.


