John A. Milne who celebrated his 90th birthday in February passed away quietly at the LaPointe Fisher Home in Guelph on July 11.

Born in Saginaw, Michigan, Mr. Milne was a long time resident of the Eden Mills area and lived on his farm at RR 1 Moffat from 1903 to 1981 when he retired to Oxford Lodge in Guelph and later moved to the nursing home. He and his wife Alva, who predeceased him in 1977, farmed all their lives and Jack was active on Nassagaweya Council, having served as councillor, reeve and warden.

A veteran of World War 1, Jack was the last surviving charter member of the Acton branch of the Royal Canadian Legion. He was a member of the Eden Mills Presbyterian Church and had participated in Eden Mills Friendly Seniors, Rockwood Sunshine Club and Acton Golden Agers.

Left to mourn his loss are: his daughter and son-in-law Blanche and Fred McNiven; granddaughters Linda, Gayle and families; grandson John McNiven and family; sisters Blanche Banner, Hamilton and Edith Barnett, Guelph; and a brother William Maxwell (Max) Milne, Rockwood. He was predeceased by his wife, Alva, a brother Jim in World War 1, and sisters Gertie Brydges, Margaret McNabb and Lotti Fitzsimon.

Funeral service was Thursday at Shoemaker funeral home with interment at Eden Mills Cemetery.
