In other years, I too have had to suffer with whatever I could get for summer employment. This summer, with job opportunities at the lowest ever, the government has once again provided the Ontario Youth Work Program. These government subsidies creating jobs for students may be seen by some as a blessing, yet many employers use the program as an excuse to take advantage of students, who are willing to accept those jobs no one else will. Bottling chemical bleach

in a company where an upside-down Javex bottle was the only toilet facility is one example among many. Filthy, back-breaking work in intolerable working environments is often the norm, and all for \$2.65 an hour, eight hours a day, sometimes seven days a week.
Unfortunately, most 16- and 17-year-old high school students do not have the work experience or the knowledge of their own rights to prevent this blatant exploitation. In the 19th century this was called child labour—in the 1980's it is legitimized and called student employment.
