

Quilt contest to celebrate Bicentennial

A province-wide quilting contest to select a Bicentennial commemorative quilt to present to the Queen has been announced by Agriculture and Food Minister Dennis Timbrell.

Entitled the "Ontario Bicentennial Quilt Contest," the competition is open to novice and artisan.

The province has selected 1984 as its Bicentennial marking the anniversary of the first major influx of settlers.

Individuals practising the historic craft of quilting will be competing for prizes of \$500 for first, \$400 for second and \$300 for third place in the contest, sponsored by the Ontario Agricultural Museum at Milton.

The province has invited her Royal Highness Queen Elizabeth II to attend the celebration of Ontario's Bicentennial. If she is able to come, the Ministry of Agriculture and Food will present Her Majesty with the first place quilt and introduce the talented winner.

Although the winners of the competition will be announced in early June 1984, the quilts will be on display at the Museum until the end of August.
