Welcome to Acton signs approved

Acton Legion received permission from Halton Hills council Monday night to put up a large welcome to Acton sign, containing logos of various service clubs and organizations in the community on it, on Highway 25 just just south of town.

In their letter and presentation Legion officials Len Shone and Gord McCutcheon explained for some time now they have been concerend about the number of signs which dot the entrances to Acton. The Legion considered putting up their own sign, but decided this would not only "aggravate the situation" as well as be a contravention of Ministry of Transportation and Communications regulations.

As a community project the Legion wants to erect large signs showing the club logos as well as the Leathertown logo. The sign, similar to the one shown in the sketch the Legion showed council, would be wood stained either redwood or mahogany with the lettering routed out and painted a contrasting color.

The first sign would be on Highway 25 south and this sign would be a pilot project. The other three entrance signs would go up later after provincial approval was secured.

While plans call for a 16 foot high sign, Shone sald specifications were adjustable.

McCutcheon asked that the Town cut the grass and keep the weeds down around the sign. Mayor Peter Pomeroy said this could be done and if Halton Hills became really "flush" maybe some flowers could be planted around the sign too.


