The study will consider truck routes; major recreation area traffic movements and scenic routes; identify existing traffic "issues"; set out a "rights-ofway schedule and identify widening specific road projects; verify classifications" in the new Official Plan: assess the network road -"capabilities" in relation to the goals set for the Town in the Official Plan, the new enlarged urban boundaries, the Highway 407 proposal and existing transportation policies; establish a short, medium and long term road network plan in keeping with future growth of Halton

The areas to be examined are: the three lane section of Guelph St. in Georgetown; the road network between Highway 7 and Confederation St. in Glen Williams and the unopened portion of 22 Sideroad east of the Eighth Line; the road network between Highway 25 and Trafalgar Rd. and roads between 15 and 22 Sideroads and the unopened portion of 17 Sideroad west of the Fourth Line; 15 Sideroad between Trafalgar and the Eighth Line and the Eighth Line south of Maple Ave. in Georgetown; Regional Rd. 13 south of Eden Pl. in Georgetown; truck traffic through ddwntown Acton; the Fourth Line and 17 Sideroad aggregate truck route and the Eighth Line. Wildwood Rd. and Confederation St. aggregate truck route in Glen Williams.




