

Transportation study for Halton Hills

Halton Hills is setting up a Transportation Study committee.

Last week council approved terms of reference for the study and also decided one member of council will sit on the committee with the Town engineer and planner as well two region staff members and two provincial officials.

This study is designed to develop a "comprehensive transportation plan" for Halton Hills.

The study will consider truck routes; major recreation area traffic movements and scenic routes; identify existing traffic "issues"; set out a "rights-of-way schedule and identify specific road widening projects; verify "road classifications" in the new Official Plan; assess the present road network "capabilities" in relation to the goals set for the Town in the Official Plan, the new enlarged urban boundaries, the Highway 407 proposal and existing transportation policies; establish a short, medium and long term road network plan in keeping with future growth of Halton

Hills; and determine costs associated with implementing the transportation study results.

The study will also look at a number of specific roads in the Town and problems associated with those roads. The areas to be examined are: the three lane section of Guelph St. in Georgetown; the road network between Highway 7 and Confederation St. in Glen Williams and the unopened portion of 22 Sideroad east of the Eighth Line; the road network between Highway 25 and Trafalgar Rd. and roads between 15 and 22 Sideroads and the unopened portion of 17 Sideroad west of the Fourth Line; 15 Sideroad between Trafalgar and the Eighth Line and the Eighth Line south of Maple Ave. in Georgetown; Regional Rd. 13 south of Eden Pl. in Georgetown; truck traffic through downtown Acton; the Fourth Line and 17 Sideroad aggregate truck route and the Eighth Line, Wildwood Rd. and Confederation St. aggregate truck route in Glen Williams.


Plans call for a consultant to be retained to do the study.

Masson named to housing board

Murray Cox, Reeve of the Eramosa Township Council, has announced that David Masson, a former council member, has been appointed to the Board of Directors of the Eramosa Non-Profit Housing Corporation.


The directors of the Corporation were informed at their recent board meeting that 17 of the 26 suites in the apartment have been spoken for. The nine remaining suites will rent for \$320 and \$365 per month for the one bedroom and the two bedroom units respectively. The rents are all inclusive of services and utilities in the apartment.

Schledel Construction Inc., the general contractor, has indicated that their present

schedule will complete the building by August 19. Landscaping is now in progress, finishing work is being completed in some suites. The Directors are expecting some tenants to be moving in on August 20 and all 26 suites will be occupied before the end of October.

Plans are now being made to hold a community open house for residents of Rockwood and Eramosa Township before the end of August, the date will be announced when the key date is known. A reception will be held for officials of the Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing, senior government persons and elected representatives, and others who have helped the community secure this very needed apartment building.
