Yugoslavs face noise charge

A Yugoslav cultural-recreation centre official is going to be charged under the Town's anti-noise bylaw after police were called to the property on Highway 25 twice Sunday.

Because the noise problem has again reared its ugly head, Halton Hills Council decided Monday night to object to the Yugoslav Centre receiving a liquor permit for the planned August 21 picnic.

One of the conditions of approval of a liquor permit for Sunday's picnic was that two off-duty policemen be hired and on the site.

Neighbor Bill McArthur, Third Line, told councillors Monday that he was informed by the police early Sunday night that no off-duty policemen were on the site.

The Town is urging the Yugoslavs not to use loud speakers and hire off-duty policemen if the August 21 picnic proceeds despite the fact the centre won't get a liquor permit.

Police went to the site once and the speaker volume was reduced. However, they received another complaint later Sunday and determined the noise level was excessive.

McArthur said neighbors felt the liquor permit should be rejected since the noise problem was again as severe as it ever has been. He added neighbors put up with the noise from 1 until after 7 p.m.

The Yugoslavs were not living up to their obligations.

Liquor permits have been approved for three previous picnics on the condition noise is kept down and off-duty police hired.

Councillor Ross Knechtel noted he went to McArthur's property around 6 p.m. and the noise volume was "unacceptable."

He added he was informed the noise was lower then and noted McArthur's home is a considerable distance away.

"They breached their agreement with us."

Councillor Dave Whiting observed this is the second time the Yugoslavs haven't kept up their part of the bargain. Last year a permit condition was no loud speakers be used and they were used, and now no off-duty police were hired as required.

Reject air cleaner, Town saves \$1,675

Halton Hills council Monday night rejected spending \$1,675 on a large window air cleaner for the chambers.

There have been numerous complaints, primarily from Councillors Marilyn Serjeantson and Pam Sheldon about stale, smoky air in the chambers.

Roughly half of recent councils, the press audience and some staff members are smokers. Attempts to ban smoking at meetings have repeatedly failed.

In the past a few small desk top air cleaners have been used in the chambers, but haven't proved very effective.

Earlier Sheldon asked staff to look at the subject of air cleaners again.

Staff contacted four firms for quotes and information about large air cleaners, there's even been one on an experimental basis in the chambers the past couple of meetings. It was noisy and kept arcing and sparking.

Councillor John McDonald suggested the motion to buy the air cleaner be received and filed. The easiest solution was for all the smoking councillors to sit on one side and the non-smokers on the other.

Noting most councillors had preached restraint at election time, Councillor Rick Bonnette noted if they wanted to practise restraint they wouldn't spend \$1,675.

Sheldon said this kind of expenditure wasn't what she had in mind, she meant small inexpensive air cleaners. She didn't want to see much money spent, and besides most smokers are sitting on the other side of the room from the and Serjeantson now.
