Town approves region rejects

An application for a one acre land severance from a five-acre parcel bought by a war veteran 35 years ago is being blocked by Halton Region.

William Gordon (Gordie) Brown of Norval made application for the severance for the construction of a separate residence last June. The application was approved by the Land Division Committee, and later by Halton Hills Council even though the town's Planning Department had opposed approval of the severance on the grounds that it did not conform with the proposed official plan for the town.

Region staff, however, have appealed the application because the surrounding strip development, which includes several houses on small lots, does not conform to the official plan definition of a "rural cluster," and that the proposed severance would affect surrounding farmland.

Halton Hills Mayor Peter Pomeroy and Councillor Russ Miller were joined by Milton Councillor Bill Johnson in support of the application. "That piece of land can't be called agricultural land by any stretch of the imagination," Johnson commented, putting forward a motion that the region withdraw its appeal.

Senior Planner Bob White said the regional planning department was basing its appeal on the official plan which would allow infill development in a rural cluster but considers the five-acre parcel to be agricultural.

Lawyer Bert Arnold, representing Brown, pointed out that the parcel is not considered good agricultural land, and therefore the severance would not hinder agriculture in the area. He added that so far there have been no objections made by local neighbors to the proposed severance.

The motion to withdraw the appeal was lost by a five-to-three vote margin.

Bell tries to cut fraud

In an effort to cut down on fraudulent long distance calling, Bell Canada, starting October 17, will verify all third number calls billed from coin telephones.

Last year, Bell operators stopped accepting third number local calls billed from coin telephones.

On April 15 of this year, on all third number long distance calls from coin telephones operators began attempting to contact the billed party to confirm that the person placing the call was known and that the charge was acceptable. However if verification was not possible because the line was busy or there was no answer, the call was still put through.

Starting October 17, all such numbers will have to be verified before the call is connected. If there is no answer or a busy signal at the billing number, the person placing the call will have the option of paying by coin, calling collect or using a long distance Calling Card, (tm) or calling another time.

Murray Makin, Bell's vice-president of customer services, said the October 17 date was chosen to allow customers who regularly make third number calls from coin telephones to obtain Calling Cards.

Calling Cards are available to qualified business or residence users at no charge and can be obtained by completing the application form that will be enclosed with August telephone bills.

In 1982 there were more than 250,000 fraudulent third number long distance calls placed from coin telephones in Bell territory resulting in a loss of more than \$1.3 million.

No objection

Halton Hills has no objection to Milton rezoning some land at the corner of the Town Line and 20 Sideroad south-west of Acton.

Milton has passed a zoning amendment to allow the building of one house on the property and Halton Hills was asked to comment since the property abuts the Town Line.
