## \$15,150 raised for NHAMR

To the Editor:

Nearly \$15,150 was raised in the annual door-to-door canvass of the North Halton Association for the Mentally Retarded this past May. This is \$5,100 more than what was raised the previous year.

A great many people worked long and hard to make the campaign so successful. Almost all of these were volunteers.

We had literally hundreds of canvassers who went door-to-door. We had scores of captains who made sure we had enough canvassers and that each canvasser had all the necessary materials. Many captains, in addition to coordinating the canvassers and tallying up the donations for their areas, also went out and canvassed door-to-door themselves.

The week long canvass was the culmination of many months of planning and preparation. Much of this work fell to a select group who had to spend many evenings and weekends to put the whole thing together.

Special recognition goes to three members of this group: Mrs. Linda Parker, who although new to the campaign this year, served as the coordinator for Georgetown; Mrs. Valda May, who was pivotal in bringing about an amazingly successful canvass of the "Hornby Area"; Mrs. Julie Conroy, who as a member of the L'Arche Auxiliary, did a find job in looking after the canvass of the Acton area again this year.

The association is most grateful for the amount of money which was contributed. We need this money in order to bridge the gap between government subsidies and our actual costs.

I would point out that all the money we receive stays here in North Halton, and is used towards the services and support we provide for mentally retarded people and their families.

We were disappointed that again this year we were unable to mount a campaign in Milton. We are now looking for friends in Milton who could help to run some kind of fund raising event there this fall or early


