**Region briefs**

**G-ahead proposed**  
 The second phase of the region's \$55,000 study of Health and Social Services for the Elderly has passed the committee stage and now awaits approval by council. The second phase will allow for public discussion on the findings of the first stage.  
 The Health and Social Services Committee is making the recommendation even though \$10,000 in grant money for the remainder of the study has yet to be approved by the province.  
 Halton Hills councillor Dave Whiting said he was not impressed with the first part of the study which cost \$35,000 and said the study should be halted.  
 "You don't throw good money after bad," he said, adding that a smaller study done by regional staff alone should be done.  
 However, the other committee members disagreed. Oakville councillor, Jackie Cutmore said statistics indicate the elderly portion of the population will expand so a proper public study is required of those services that will be needed.

**Request Ignored**  
 Regional councillors would be cutting their own throats if they supported a bid to draw attention to what has been called a "steady erosion of property rights through government legislation at all levels," ruled the Administration and Finance Committee last week.  
 Accordingly, they will not support the Metropolitan Hamilton Real Estate Board's effort to have October 2-10 proclaimed Private Property Week.  
 In a letter to council, board representative Cameron Jackson said that while governments must care for the general good, "they must also recognize the rights of the individual."  
 "Private Property Week will re-affirm the rights of Canadians to own, use and enjoy private property," he said.
