Don Van Polen, a professional, award winning photographer will be coming to Georgetown as part of his cross Canada tour to show "Springtime in Holland". Enrolment up 7.8%

Enrolment of full-time post-secondary students at Sheridan College is 6,642, an increase of 7.8 per cent over last year. The 1983/84 registration statistics were presented to the College Board of Governors during its September meeting by Vice-President Barrie Wray. Original forecasts of enrolment increases for this year were between four and seven per cent.

Wray told the Board that the increased numbers of students are distributed fairly

evenly across the spectrum of programs. Programs being offered for the first time this year include: the two-year Esthetician program, School of Fashion Arts, Oakville (48 Year 1 students); two-year program in Integrated Office Systems, offered through the School of Business and Secretarial Studies at the Oakville Campus (77 Year 1 students) and at Brampton through the School of Information and Computer Systems (10 Year 1 students); and Courseware Design and Production.
