The remains of the house on Willow St. North where a tragic fire claimed two lives this past summer was finally demolished Thursday. Owner of the property, as well as the rest home to the west, Village Manor, David Johnson, said it hasn't been determined yet what will be done with this lot.

Police beat

Police report four liquor charges were laid over the weekend to persons aged 17-34. Three Acton men were charged with being intoxicated in a public place and an Acton woman was charged with drinking under age.

A firearm was seized and a woman committed for observation under the Mental Health Act after police were called to a domestic disturbance involving a common law husband and wife on Sunday night. There were no injuries and no charges in connection with the incident at a Guelph St. residence.

An attempted break and enter was made at a Kingham Rd. home sometime during the night, last Monday-Tuesday. A basement window, valued \$25, was broken, but no entry was gained.

A mini tape recorder, an unknown amount of change and a 1953 Coronation token were stolen in a break-in at a Wescott Drive home, sometime Sunday. The thieves got in by breaking a bathroom window valued at \$50.

The police investigation is continuing in connection with a domestic disturbance involving a father and daughter at a Queen St. home, Friday night.

The front window of a Willow St. residence was broken at about 2:30 a.m. Saturday. It is not known what was used to break the window. Damage is estimated at \$50.

A 19-year-old Acton male was assaulted at the corner of Church and John streets at about 10:45 p.m. Sunday. The man was driving his car and was cut off at the corner by a brown Cutlass. A suspect got out and hit the victim in the face several times resulting in facial bruising. Police are on the lookout for a 25-year-old man, six feet tall, about 180 lbs. with short brown hair. The suspect was wearing a red Halloween costume with a long cape.

Molotov cocktails were thrown at three homes during the weekend, police report. At 12:30 a.m. Friday, one was thrown on the front lawn of a Churchill Rd. N. home causing no damage. At 11:30 p.m. on Friday one was thrown on the road in front of a McDonald Blvd. home causing no damage. At 10:35 p.m. on Sunday one was thrown on the road in front of an Elmore Dr. home causing no damage. In connection with the last occurrence, police are looking for an old, dark Ford or Chevrolet pick-up, containing three males about 21-years-old. One of the suspects had dirty blonde hair and wore a windbreaker.
