Mrs. Hannah explained the first Craft of

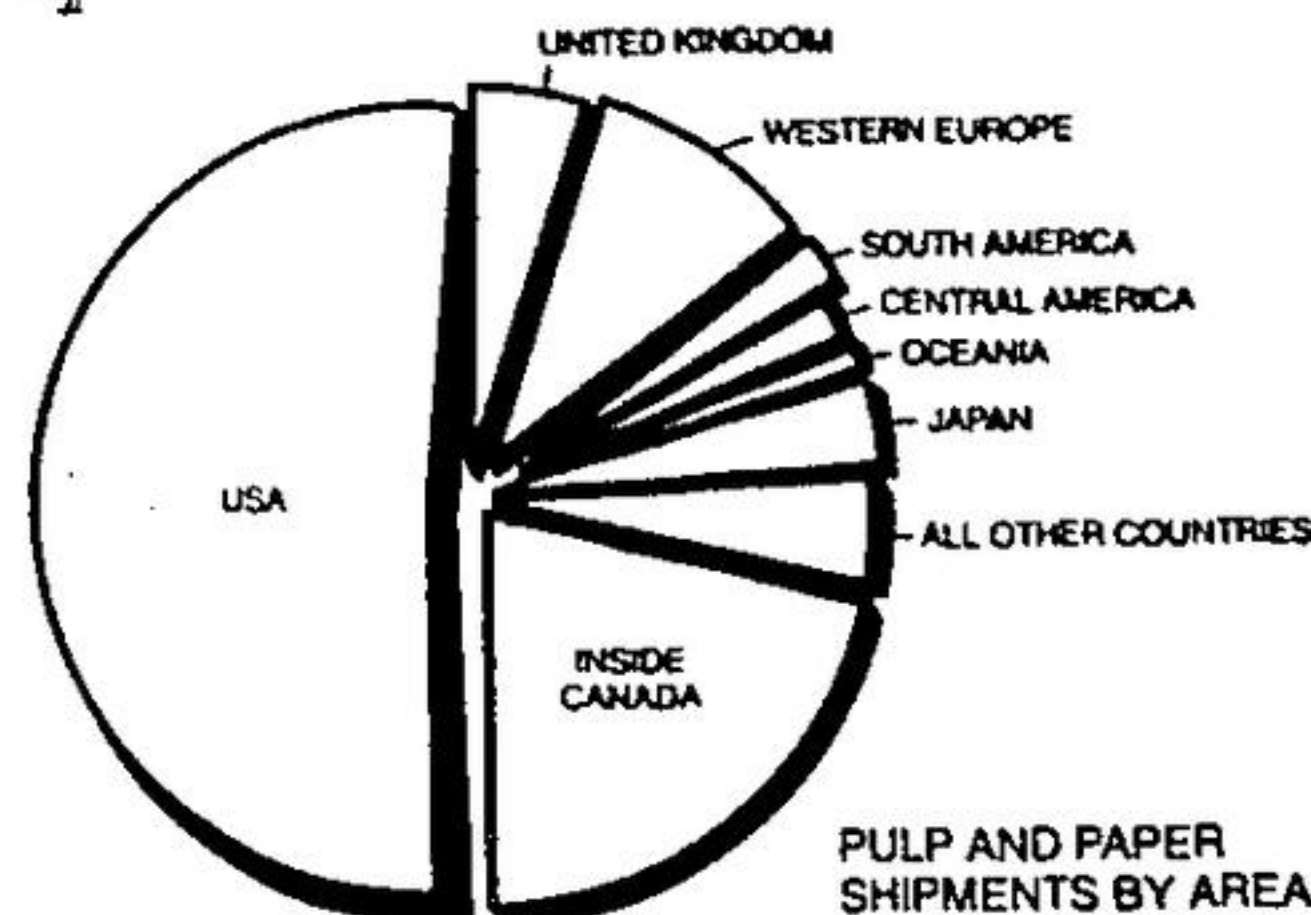

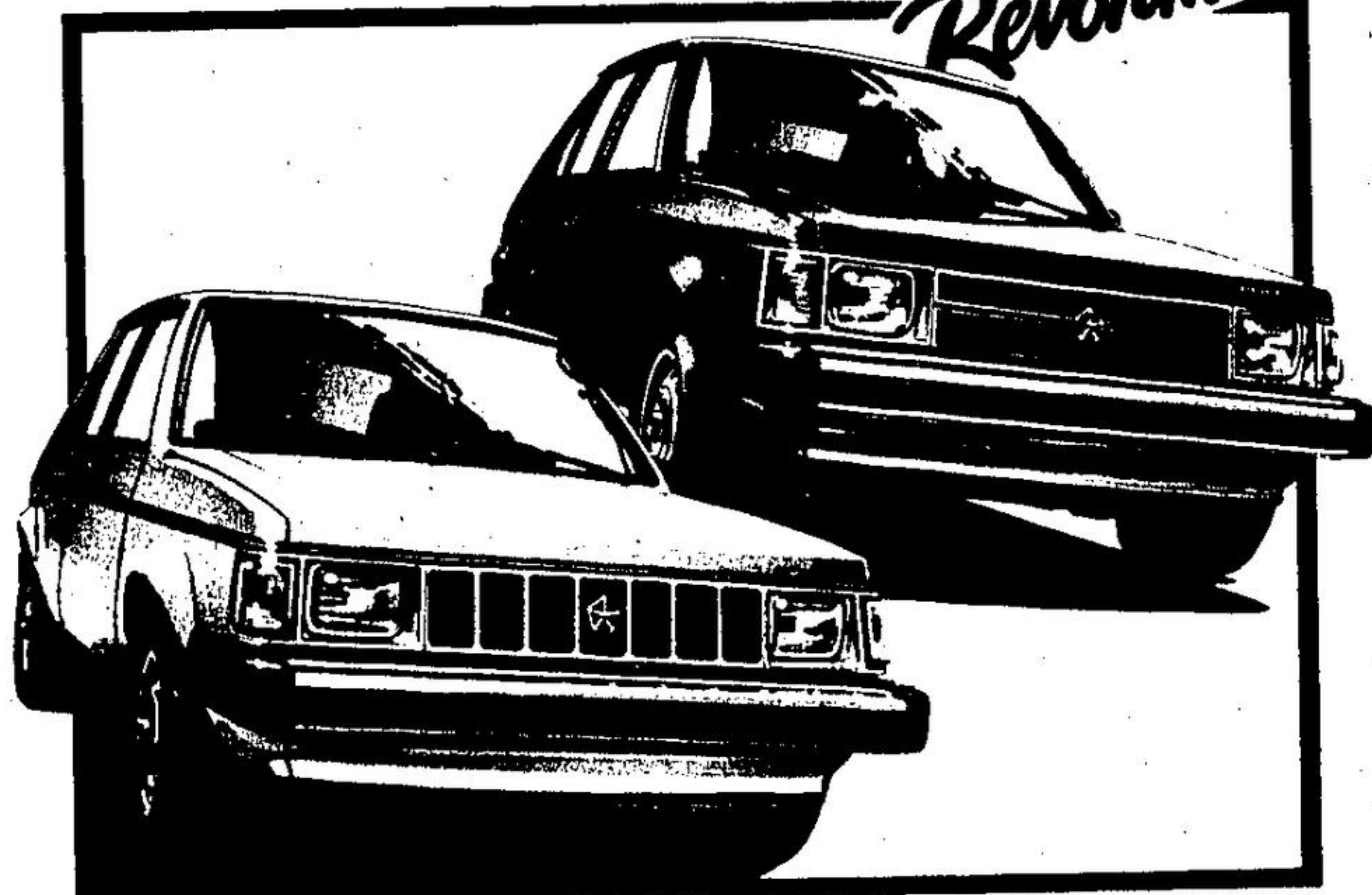

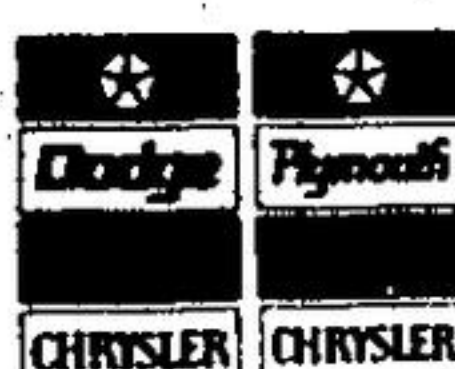
