

Sheldon urges

Teach school children about local government

There's a need for some kind of program in Ontario schools teaching the future voters about the local system of government, according to Councillor Pam Sheldon.

Council recently received and noted a resolution from Stratford dealing with educating children about local government. Sheldon wanted the Stratford motion endorsed, but other councillors didn't like the wording and urged Sheldon come back in a few weeks with a resolution she framed herself.

Pointing to the low voter turnout for the recent Esqueping by-election, Sheldon said there is a need for a program in the schools

because there is "so little understanding" on the part of the public where their local tax dollars go.

Councillor Mike Armstrong noted it would be many years before children learning about local government in school have the chance to vote, the people who didn't vote in the by-election were in school 15 years ago.

Halton Hills has received numerous resolutions from Stratford this year and Armstrong observed "none have made any sense."

Sheldon said she was well aware there would be no impact of teaching children about local government for many years, however it was time to do something "positive."

Mayor Peter Pomeroy pointed out he speaks at schools about local government frequently, but felt it would be helpful if there was a format for teaching local government in schools.
