





Barbara Johnson appointed to Housing Authority

Mrs. Barbara Johnson of Limehouse has been appointed to the Halton Housing Authority, Municipal Affairs and Housing Minister Claude Bennett announced. Johnson, a supply teacher, will serve as a federal representative on the sevenmember authority which manages Ontario Housing Corporation's 1,065 assisted housing units in Halton Hills, Burlington, Milton and Oakville.

The federal, provincial and municipal governments nominate individuals for appointment to the housing authorities by provincial orders-in-council. The province appoints the housing authority chairman.

The Halton Housing Authority manages 831 senior citizen assisted housing units and 234 units for low-income families.
