## Murt Allison is chairman

Murt Allison is the new chairman of the Halton Hills Hydro Commission. Allison was acclaimed to the office Wednesday at the commission's regular monthly meeting. The Esqueping representative replaced Bill Smith, from Georgetown who held the post for the first year of the commission's current three year term. Georgetown commissioner Ab Tennant was elected vice-chairman, after Acton representative Doug Mason declined the nomination.

## Reserve funds gets board thumbs down

Halton Board of Education squashed two attempts to have monies placed in reserve funds for computers and employee wages.

At their regular meeting Thursday evening, trustees first voted down a recommendation that \$125,000 be placed in elementary reserve for working funds and \$100,000 be placed in a secondary reserve to meet 1985 liabilities resulting from the Inflation Restraint Act last September.

In a report to the board, Elaine Riehm, chairman of the salary policy committee noted that as a result of the act, several employees are receiving salaries which are less than they are entitled to. Increments and qualification changes have been withheld for those making more than \$35,000.

The report continued that the new Inflation Restraint legislation proposes to remove the foregoing provision. As a result, the new collective agreements and other compensation plans for employee groups will recog-

nize this shortfall in the next salary year.

The majority of trustees disagreed with this and voted against it.

At the same meeting, trustees also decided not to place a total of over half a million dollars for computers into a reserve for working funds.

Trustee Noel Cooper recommended \$170,000 for elementary and \$225,000 for secondary be placed in the funds to meet the needs of the Computer Advisory Committee.

Cooper, in a report to the board, noted in January, 1983 the Advisory Committee showed the board a five-year plan for computer usage in Halton schools.

Year One of the plan was supported by the board, but budget limitations severely hampered its total implementation.

Cooper felt by placing this money in the capital reserve fund, the board would be reaffirming their commitment to the 1983 plan.

## Face masks are available

The Halton Lung Association has face masks available to be worn in cold weather for those who experience difficulty in breathing.

Dr. R.W.T. Haddon of Joseph Brant Memorial Hospital, Medical Director of the Family Asthma Programs and Better Breathing Classes, advised that the "Cold Weather Masks" were devised to prevent the onset of bronchospasm as a result of breathing very cold air. The masks are designed to be worn a short period of time only (10-15 minutes).

The patient wears this mask as he leaves home and is able to inhale, through a corrugated tube, air which has been warmed by his own body. The use of a one way valve enables the patient to always receive fresh warm air each inhalation as well as eliminate carbon dioxide upon exhalation.

Cold Weather Masks can be obtained from the Halton Lung Association at a cost of \$2.50.

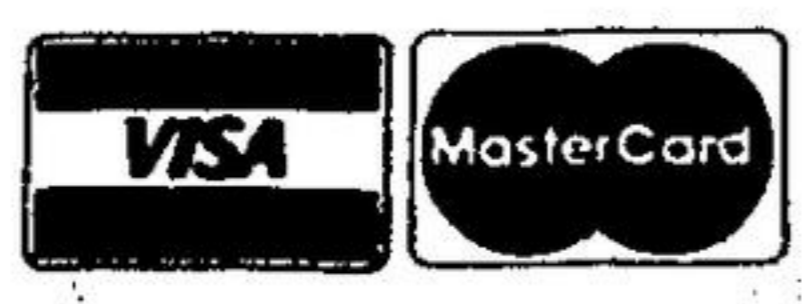
