Halton Hills council appointees are Ian Carter and Norman Elliott whose terms expire in 1985 and 1984 respectively.

The vacancy created by the resignation of Doug Magwood, the third Town appointee, has not yet been filled.

An RR 5 Georgetown woman escaped injury after being involved in a two car crash on Highway 24, two miles north of Osprey, Thursday morning.

Guelph OPP say Lesley Hale, 41, was driving a car which was in collision with another vehicle driven by Frederick Dunn, 60, of Oakville at 9.45 a.m. One of the cars had been parked on the east shoulder of the road and pulled out onto Highway 24. The other car couldn't get stopped in time on the icy roads, police say. The crash occurred just at the crest of a hill.

Police estimate damages at \$800 to the Dunn vehicle and \$1,800 to the Hale car. There were no injuries and no charges laid.
