**POLICIES:**  
All courses are filled on a first come first served basis. Those under 16 must be registered by their parent. Closures are to be made payable to "The Town of Halton Hills". Post dated cheques will not be accepted. Parents are advised not to register a child for one level until the previous level has been completed. Refunds will be given if a participant notifies the Pool Manager IN WRITING at least 48 hours before the program begins. All refunds are subject to a \$10.00 administration fee.

If a class is cancelled by the Recreation Department a full refund will be given. The Halton Hills Recreation & Parks Dept. reserves the right to cancel or change the class, times, or fees outlined in this brochure if required due to registration, change of policy or availability of instructors.

### FAMILY DISCOUNT

First person pays full rate. Each additional person gets a \$2.00 discount. This discount is valid only when two or more people in one family register for swimming lessons at the same time.

### YOUTH LESSONS

All of the swimming lessons offered at the Acton and Georgetown Swimming Pools run for 10 weeks. If a class is cancelled by the Recreation Department for any reason, lessons will be held the next consecutive week on the usual day and time.

### NOTE TO PARENTS

1. Some of the swimming levels now have minimum age recommendations. We have found that, for the most part, children younger than the ages we recommend, may not be physically strong enough to complete the level. If your child is below the recommended age, we would suggest that you wait a session or two before continuing swimming lessons, and bring your child to weekly family swims.
