Branch 197 wants no peace demonstrations at the local cenotaph

Acton Legion, Branch 197, intends to inform Halton Hills council they don't want peace demonstrations at the local cenotaph. It hasn't been an issue here. However, after a war memorial was the scene of a peace demonstration in Toronto on Remembrance Day in Toronto last year, the provincial command of the Legion has spoken out. A letter has been sent to every Ontario Legion requesting that their executive contact the local municipality to ask that there be no peace demonstrations at the local cenotaphs. Legion president Len Shone said the executive will be drafting a letter on this matter to be sent to Halton Hills council in the near future.

He also released the following statement: "Regarding peace groups using war memorials as a focus for demonstrations, the executive and membership of Branch 197, Royal Canadian Legion, fully endorses the views put forward by our Provincial Secretary, Reg Cleator. "However, this has never been an issue here in Acton. I am sure that many Legion members do not doubt the sincerity of such demonstrators. We appreciate the respect shown to our cenotaph by the various protest groups in the area. The memory of those of our comrades who made the supreme sacrifice must always be put above partisan or political debate."
