

Ever have a couple of egg whites in the fridge and you don't know what to do with them? Make cup-cake coconut meringues.

Put the egg whites in a bowl and beat until they stand in peaks. Add half a cup of white sugar slowly and continue beating. Add a little flavoring, vanilla or almond. Fold in half a cup of flour to which a quarter of a teaspoon of cream of tartar has been added. Then fold in a cup of shredded coconut. Put cupcake liners in your muffin tins and fill to the brim. Add your cherry to the top. Now cook in a 225 degree oven until golden and firm. Shut off oven and leave in for five or 10 minutes. The liner will peel off when they are cold.
