

Town gives salvage yards until May 31 to conform

Strong objections by Councillor Sheldon, 1983 licences were extended for Halton Auto Wreckers and six other salvage yards until May 31 last week by a Hills general committee.

than the other because it is right in a hamlet. Limehouse, Councillor Jake Kuiken observed.

Councillors settled on a May 31 deadline for Halton Wreckers, Johnson Auto Wreckers, Halton Hills Collision, Lee's Auto Wreckers and Brown's Wrecking Yard conforming to the bylaw or they'll lose their licences.

Law enforcement officer Jack Lusty stated that the 1983 licences be extended at the end of June so yard owners don't use the excuse of winter weather pending repairs.

Sheldon complained that very little has been done to solve the problems at Halton Wreckers in Limehouse since the first complaint in the fall of 1982. She said delegations have come from Limehouse, the problems have been discussed, but the Town bylaw was beefed up, the problems persist. She claimed the reason the bylaw was amended to put teeth in it was because of Halton Auto Wreckers. Council hasn't received complaints about other yards. The tougher bylaw was passed last fall, so all yards had to prepare before it took effect at the end of this year, she declared.

Councillor Mike Armstrong noted none of the yards completely fit the requirements of the bylaw yet and council couldn't approve them except Halton Auto Wreckers. One of the new regulations just came into effect at the start of this year, clerk-administrator Ken Richardson noted. He said the council could deny a licence, but that it requires due notice and a hearing. Action was taken against one yard it had to be taken against all of them, Richardson warned. He said he'd like to see all the yards given until the end of June to complete the required work and he'd like to see repairs would be dragged out if they had until the end of June.

Richardson said once nice weather arrives the red work at each yard should only take four weeks. Richardson noted each yard will be advised that council expects to completely conform to the bylaw in respect by the deadline and that they should serve as prior notice to the yards that they face losing their licences.
