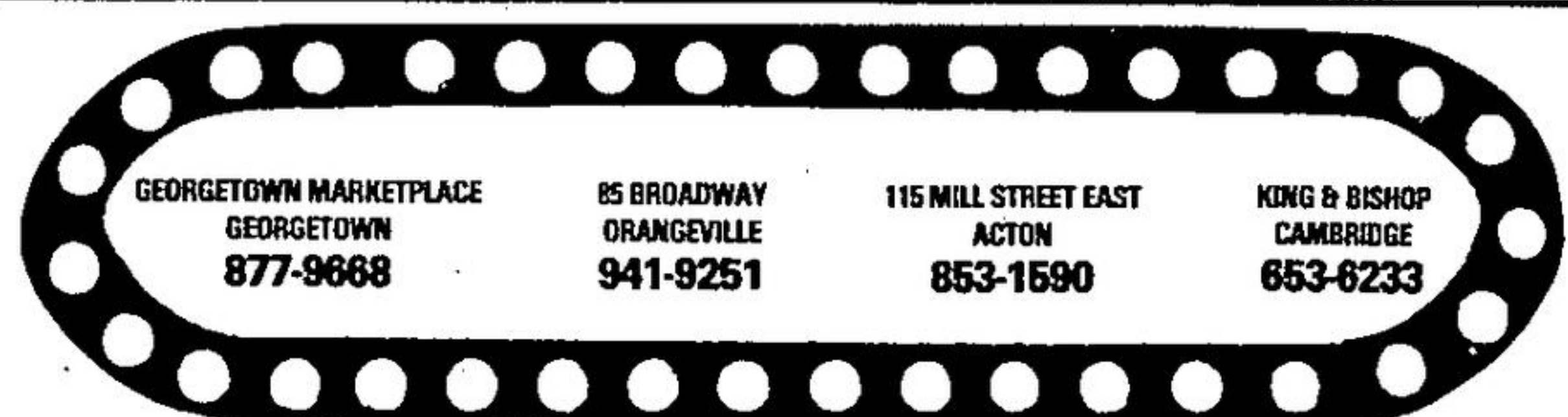

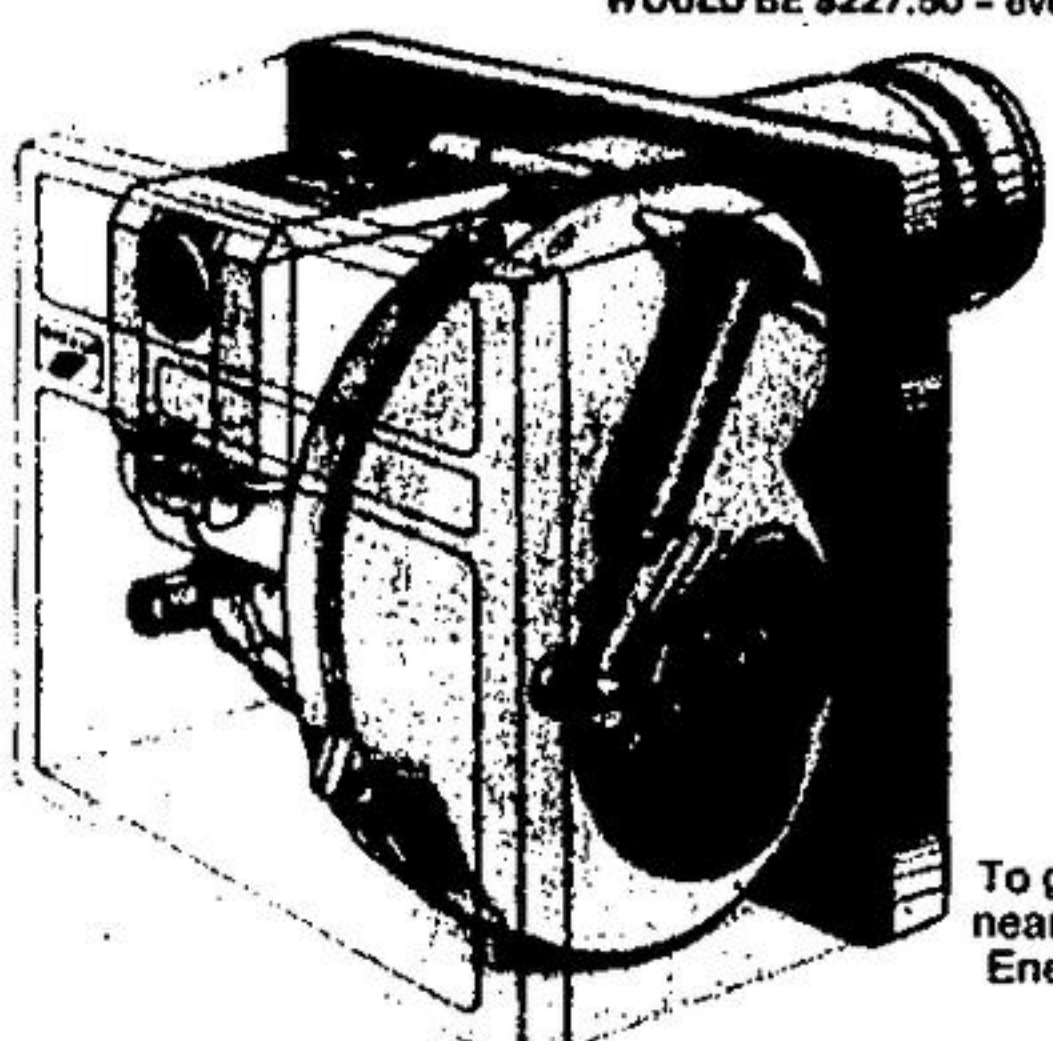

Police beat

About \$500 damage resulted when vandals jumped on the hood of a car parked outside Acton High School, sometime between Friday and Saturday.
About \$30 damage resulted when Jug City in Acton was broken into Friday at about 4 a.m. Entry was gained through a rear window, but police believe the culprits were frightened off.
A 47-year-old rural Acton man was arrested for being intoxicated in a public place last Monday evening.
Police say about 9:21 p.m. the man was seen "hanging from a lamp" on Mill St. When he fell down he was arrested and lodged overnight.
