

Firefighters hose down Flamboro in OMHA

After downing Flamboro three games to one the Acton Firefighter Major Bantams are advancing to the OMHA quarter final play-offs.

In the final three games of the best three out of five series Acton tallied a 6-5 and a 7-2 win while Flamboro managed one 7-5 victory.

All three games had both teams stretching themselves to their limits but Acton came out on top with Darryle Bartlett leading the local squad with six markers and Peter Cargill notched five in the series.

The two leading scorers both reached the 50 goal mark this season as well.

In game two Mike Peters pegged two markers, Cargill managed a hat-trick and David Haynes added a single for the win.

Acton assists were made by Cargill, Haynes, Mike Baker and Brett Carachi.

In round three Bartlett tallied a hat-trick and Cargill and Peters added singles but an early Flamboro lead kept the Acton squad out of the winner's circle. Peters, Ron Robinson, Paul Kilpatrick, Baker and Scott Nellis aided on the Acton markers.

However, in round four the Firefighters Bants came back fighting and Bartlett chalked up a hat-trick to led the Acton squad

to victory. David Haynes, Sean Fitzgerald, Cargill and Kilpatrick added singles. Acton aids came from Cargill, Carachi, Kilpatrick, Bartlett and Haynes.

The Bantams will host Beamsville tonight (Wednesday) at 8 p.m. in round one of the OMHA quarter finals. Game two will be held in Beamsville March 3 at 3:30 p.m.

The local Bants also played an exhibition match this week losing 6-5 to the Georgetown "AA" club.

Georgetown racked up an awesome four goal advantage in the first period to lead Acton throughout the game but three goals in the second period and two markers in the third period edged the Firefighters within one goal of their opponents.

Carachi led the Acton assault with a pair of goals and Baker, Cargill and Kilpatrick nailed singles. Cargill, Mike Howarth, Robinson, Bartlett and Gord Taillefer assisted on the plays.
