## Town tightens up rural recreation restrictions

Halton Hills has moved to make it even more difficult for major recreation facilities and centres to spring up anywhere in the rural area.

Present zoning only allows minor recreation uses in the rural area, bur Halton Hills doesn't control all rural lands through its zoning and new Official Plan policies.

Part of the rural area of the Town is controlled by Niagara Escarpment Commission (NEC) rules, regulations, and policies.

Where local restrictions are tighter than NECrules, the local restrictions are deemed to be in force.

Currently certain types of NEC zoning or land use designations in the Halton Hills rural area allow major recreation uses and facilities.

Now Halton Hills is going to change its Official Plan so that only minor recreation uses are allowed on lands covered by NEC Scarp Protection Area and Complementary Use Area in Halton Hills.

Major and minor recreation use restrictions cover both public and private parks and facilities.
