## Study bottom or put a layer of stones in the botcouncil

After more than a year of study, Regional Council now has the final report on its role in health and social services for Halton's elderly.

It is the fifth study of the needs and services for the elderly in the region since 1977 and makes 18 recommendations to regional council.

Amoung the recommendations of the study team of Peat Marwick and Peter G. Crichton & associates, management consuitants:

-That Halton adopt a housing policy emphasizing the maintenance of the elderly In their own communities in "an integrated and independent fashion." A housing coordinator should also be hired to undertake a housing study.

-A major restructuring of Halton Centennial Manor should be conducted over a 10 year period. The Manor would operate as a small core facility in Milton while private, non-profit and voluntary chronic care options would be encouraged in the other communities.

-That Supplementary Aid be provided to pensioners in the form of a taxi fare assistance program to lessen the impact on the elderly of high taxi costs.

-Social service grants should be used to develop new community support services. Existing services should be funded with purchase of service agreements with the region rather than grants, as is now the case, in order to give council more control over standards.

-The region should study the feasibility of a consumer and professional awareness program for health and social services for the elderly.

-The region should work closely with the Halton District Health Council and all hospitals in Halton to develop a placement coordination service.

The findings and recommendations of the elderly study will be debated by regional council today.
