



## Propose bigger hydro deposit

Halton Hills Hydro customers may have to pay a bigger deposit before their hydro will be hooked up.

The proposal, brought forth at last week's Hydro Commission meeting by Bill Smith is a measure being considered to offset the commission's losses through non-payment of hydro bills. In 1982 the commission lost over \$9,000 through non-payment.

Presently, tenants in Halton Hills paying for their own hydro must deposit a minimum of \$50 which goes toward paying the customer's final bill.

Currently the customer's \$50 deposit does not collect interest but under the new

proposal the interest collected on a deposit will also go towards a customer's final bill.

#### Hydro purchases 230 new poles

Guelph Utility Pole will supply 230 fully treated pine poles at a cost of \$53,660 to Halton Hills Hydro.

The poles come in a variety of sizes ranging from 30 feet to 60 feet and will be used to replace worn out poles on existing lines and to service new lots.




