**Town expects \$51,000 in permits**

With the economy improving Halton Hills is aiming to collect more money in building permits than last year.

According to the 1984 Town budget, \$51,000 will be earned in building permits this year. That figure was bumped by \$10,000 by budget committee during deliberations from the initial staff estimate of \$41,000.

Last year the Town estimated it would collect \$32,000 in building permits. Past Halton Hills experience has shown the municipality picks up about \$62,000 from building permits.

Other estimates of revenue from permits include \$11,000 for plumbing permits, \$220 for occupancy permits and \$300 for entrance (access to property) permits.
