School budget approved
Halton Board of Education Thursday evening approved a 1984 budget of \$147.5 million, an increase of 8.4 per cent over last year.
In a press release from Bill Priestner, chairman of the Finance committee, he noted: "This budget maintains the level of service provided in 1983 for regular programs and provides for expansion of service in special education, French language instruction and classroom use of computers."
In Halton Hills, the increase works out to about a \$48 increase to each home for the education tax apportionment alone.
In speaking to his fellow trustees, Priestner pointed out surrounding school boards are experiencing approximately the same rate of increase, except Hamilton, which will be about 4.5 per cent.
Ron Warren, superintendent of business services, pointed out board expenditures are only increasing five per cent over last year, but because provincial grants only increased 8/10s of one per cent, taxes are up over eight per cent.
Priestner pointed out a two per cent decline in average enrolment has been projected. This has been taken into consideration in the budget. Salaries are within the provincial government's five per cent guidelines, and there will be 26 fewer elementary teachers and 31 fewer secondary instructors.
Included in the budget will be \$35,000 for grade 7 and 8 textbook needs; \$50,000 to start a replacement program for elementary classroom furniture, money to replace windows in elementary schools and to replace or repair heating equipment; money to extend French Immersion to Grade 7, \$131,550 for computers at the elementary level and \$175,000 at the secondary level.
In a recorded vote, all the trustees voted in favor of the adoption of the budget, with the exception of Oakville's Paddy Hughes, who was absent.
