**\$175,643 of \$642,433 fire budget spent on volunteers**

Operating the Town's fire department will cost an estimated \$642,433 in 1984 according to the recently passed Halton Hills budget. Of the total fire budget, only \$175,643 will be spent directly on the volunteers themselves. This \$175,643 will pay firefighters honorariums; benefits; uniforms and clothing for the volunteers for fires and dress occasions; car allowance, mileage and meals; medicals; education and training, seminars and conventions; and memberships and subscriptions. This part of the budget had been set at \$182,343, but \$6,700 was cut by budget committee.

In the area of fire fighting equipment, another \$139,286 will be spent by the Town. Included in this area of municipal spending will be \$66,703 in rentals on fire hydrants which are owned by the region. Supplies for vehicles will cost an estimated \$2,070, while other operating supplies are pegged at \$31,405. Repairs and maintenance of fire fighting equipment carry an anticipated cost of \$18,000 and insurance on equipment is set in the budget at \$9,108.

Acton fire department is getting a new fire hose dryer worth \$5,500, while a traffic light control system for firefighters racing from the Georgetown station will cost \$6,500.

Council set aside \$10,000 towards the \$100,000 fire training tower in the 1984 Maple Ave. fire hall budget. Budget committee also chopped \$4,500 from the budget which had been earmarked for fencing at the rear of the Georgetown fire hall training area, but did approve \$3,000 for the addition of a storage room in that building.

In total \$11,055 will be spent on cleaning and maintenance supplies at the Maple Ave. building as well as on heat, hydro and water.

Budget committee chopped \$300 from the building repair and maintenance budget, leaving \$8,000. In addition another \$6,367 will be spent covering other expenses for this fire hall.

The Guelph Ave., Georgetown, fire dispatch office costs relatively little, only \$1,822 for cleaning and maintenance supplies, repairs, utilities, etc.

At the Acton fire hall \$3,375 is being spent on a fire detection system while \$18,391 is earmarked for building maintenance, repairs, cleaning, utilities, etc.

Supplies, tires, gas and oil, repairs, etc. to mobile fire equipment (cars, trucks and pumps) is pegged at \$28,985. For fuel alone the Town will spend an estimated \$9,760.

Fire department administration and fire prevention services were chopped down \$1,310 for salary and benefits and a filing cabinet by budget committee for a final total of \$159,804. Shelving in the fire office in Georgetown is pegged to cost \$1,300, while a typewriter is expected to set the Town back \$1,000. The budget had reflected \$750 for a filing cabinet, but this amount was trimmed back to \$290.

Fire department communications has a total budget of \$86,345, including \$26,148 for wages and benefits. Budget committee slashed \$2,500 from this part of the budget by deciding to buy just two mobile radios valued at \$5,000 instead of three for \$7,500.

Another \$29,000 is set aside to buy a fire department dispatch recording device. In addition \$11,700 is pegged for spending on two portable radios and chargers, a rapid charger, eight pagers, 15 pager cases and a remote speaker and microphone.
