

Halton Hills accepts PARTICIPaction challenge

The Town of Halton Hills has accepted the "Great Canadian Participaction Challenge" from another community our size—Red Deer, Alberta. Just for the fun of it—we'll compete against other Canadian towns with a population of 30,000-39,999 to see who can get the greatest percentage of residents to exercise for 15 continuous minutes on Wednesday, May 16.

That's all there is to it! If every school child participates in the Challenge, we will have reached about 20 per cent of the population. The remaining 80 per cent of Halton Hills residents are either pre-schoolers or adults. This is where the Town is counting on you and your group to help us out! They'd like to have every Service Club, Senior Citizens Group, Nursery School, Sports Team, Women's Institute and other Community Organization make a commitment to exercise for 15 minutes for the "Challenge".

The Organizing Committee has thought of a number of simple and fun ways that could be used to get people participating. For example...

- The members of a Senior Citizens Group could go for a walk.
- Minor Sports Groups could arrange mini games—children vs. parents.
- Fitness Clubs, Racquet Clubs, Schools of Dance, etc. could offer a 15 minute free introductory lesson to recruit more members.

—Office staff could take a 15 minute exercise break in place of a coffee break.

—Business owners and their staff could gather 15 minutes before they open up shop and take a walk.

—Ride your bicycle to school or work...mow your lawn...take your pet for a walk...

Cable TV Channel 4, will be airing "15 Minute Workouts" on Wednesday, May 16 where one of the Town's fitness instructors will lead you through a number of moderate exercises. Join In!

Mayor's Race set for June 10

The Halton Hills Recreation and Parks Department is busy planning for the sixth annual Mayor's Road Race. The date for the race is Sunday, June 10 at 8:30 a.m. Again this year there will be a 5 km. route for Halton Hills residents only and an open 10 km. route.

There are several new features this year which the Town hopes will make the race more interesting.

In the 5 km. race they are awarding five age categories as well as the parent and child category. Again they are having a wheelchair category for those individuals who require mobility aids. A new category in the 5K race is the BiCentennial Team consisting of a maximum of 10 individuals (three of whom must be women). The sum of all members ages is to add up to 200 years!

In the 10K race they have two categories,

an open one for runners under 40 years and a masters category for runners over 40 years.

BiCentennial Medallions will be awarded to the first, second and third place male and female runners in each category. In the 5K race a medallion will be awarded to the 1st place male and female to complete the race. All entrants to complete the race will receive a certificate.

This year there is a family discount rate so be sure to register early.

There will be a pancake breakfast following the race at the Gordon Alcott Arena. T-shirts will also be on Sale. This race is sanctioned by the Ontario Track and Field Association and is being coordinated by the Halton Hills Recreation and Parks Department.




